



WARNING: Do not dive the Mackenzie if the ebb at Fulford Harbour is more than 4 feet in less than 6 hours.

The Canadian destroyer escort Mackenzie was built by Canadian Vickers Ltd, Montreal, and commissioned on 6 October 1962 being the flagship of his class. On 30 June 1973, the Mackenzie's crew boarded and seized the M/V Marysville, resulting in a million dollar "drug bust." She also "played" on an episode of the program "X-Files" which was shown nationally on 10 March 1996. Purchase by the Artificial Reef Society of British Columbia and made environmentally safe, the Mackenzie was sunk near Gooch Island off Sidney, British Columbia, on 16 September 1995.
